Sir/Madam:

In compliance with NGS-Cluster VI Office Order No. 2006-02 dated January 03, 2006, to conduct validation of the addresses of Non-Governmental Organizations/Peoples Organizations (NGOs/POs) and Suppliers within Metro Manila involved in the GMA Farm Inputs and Implements Fund, we are submitting herewith the results of our validation.

The following NGOs/POs were found in the addresses mentioned/listed in our copy during the validation period:

1. National Organization for Agricultural Enhancement & Productivity, Inc. (NOAEP Inc) - transferred to 934 - D Aurora Blvd. Cubao, Quezon City.
2. Samahan ng mga Manininda ng Prutas sa Gabi, Inc. - 178 Barcelona St. San Juan, Metro Manila.
3. Aaron Foundation Phil., Inc. - 2346 Juan Luna St. Gagalaingin, Tondo, Manila.
4. People's Org. for Progress & Dev't. Foundation Inc. (POPDFI) - Block 23 Lot 59 Phase 2 EP Housing Village Western Bicutan Taguig, Metro Manila
5. Philippine Social Development Foundation Inc. (PSDFI) - Block 23 Lot 1 AFPOVAI Phase 2, Western Bicutan Taguig, Metro Manila.
6. Masaganang Ani Para sa Magsasaka Foundation, Inc. (MAMFI) - No. 16 Guevarra St. Paltok, Quezon City.
7. Rural Empowerment Assistance & Development Foundation (READ Foundation), Inc. - transferred to RM 202 Joefer building along Commonwealth Avenue Diliman Quezon City.

The above-mentioned foundations/organizations have signage outside their offices or residences. The first four (4) foundations have an office, office equipment and personnel, while the existence of the rest can not be ascertain since their offices/residences were closed during the time of inspection/validation.

The following NGOs/POs were not found/traced during validation:

1. Gabaymasa Development Foundation, Inc. - Verification of the given address (72 Encarnacion St BF Homes, Quezon City) shows no signage or whatsoever identification for such entity. At the address is a two (2) door two (2) storey residential unit within the subdivision. Interviews from the personnel of the nearby

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motor works repair shop indicate that they don't know the existence of the said group in the area. However, based from security guards' record/masterlist of residence inside the subdivision, the owner of the residential unit is a certain Margie T. Luz, which upon checking with our records happens to be the listed president of the foundation.

2. Las Marias Foundation, Inc. - There was no sign or identification of the foundation outside. Based from our interviews, the said address (Block T1 Lot 2 Bonifacio Drive, Wilton Heights, Pasong Tamo, Quezon City) is the residence of a certain Henry Dupalco, a bank employee. The nearby residents have no knowledge of the group neither the names listed as trustees and incorporators of the entity.
3. SIKAP YAMAN Foundation-There was no sign or identification of the foundation outside. The address (215-G D. Tuazon St. Quezon City) is one of the two storey several door residential apartment inside a compound. Neighbors in the compound know nothing about the entity and the persons listed as incorporators.
4. Philippine Environment & Ecological Development Association, Inc. - The said address (4<sup>th</sup> Floor Stars Condominium Building Salcedo St. Legaspi Village, Makati City) was in a multi-storey building at the commercial area of Makati City. RMN network is the present occupant of the given address.
5. Masaganang Mga Bukirin Foundation Inc. - There was no 18 D Kanlaon St. Maharlika SMH, Quezon City. A two-storey residential house was found in the address (18 Kanlaon St. SMH Maharlika, Quezon City). There was no identifying sign of the entity outside. According to the Barangay Captain of the area, the entity did not exist in his area of responsibility.
6. Bukid Tanglaw Livelihood Foundation Inc. - There was no sign or identification of the entity. The said address (5-C Lansberg Place Tomas Morato St., Quezon City) was in a multi storey building along Tomas Morato St. The latest address (33-B Macopa St.) given to the undersigned was one of the two-storey several door residential apartment. There was also no sign or identification of the foundation. Security guard of the nearby apartment unit knows nothing about the existence of the entity and that the resident is a certain Mr. Garcia.

For the suppliers validated, Feshan Phils., Inc. was found to be existing at the given address (Unit D 5<sup>th</sup> Floor West Gate Tower, Investment Drive Ayala Alabang. It has an office, office equipment and personnel. Madarca Trading was not found/traced at the given address (4-A Apo St. SMH, Quezon City). A certain Anos Research presently occupies the unit. Interviews from the personnel of the nearby unit said that they don't know of the said entity.
