As per the Charter of the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP),

member of the DAP Board of Trustees.

Among the responsibilities of the DAP Board of Trustees is to elect the DAP President whenever there is a vacancy in the said position. The position of DAP President will be vacant by 31 May 2006 in view of the retirement of outgoing DAP President Eduardo T. Gonzalez, which the DAP Board of Trustees already accepted and approved during its March 31, 2006 meeting.

In the said DAP Board meeting, it was agreed upon that, since the position of DAP President is not a Presidential appointment but a career position with a permanent plantilla item, the selection has to go through the motion of a process pursuant to the requirements of the Civil Service Commission (CSC) before the election of a new President is held. The selection process is now on-going and will culminate during a DAP Board meeting on April 28, 2006, Friday, 6 p.m., at the Audio-Visual Room of the DAP Building, San Miguel Avenue, Pasig City.

In this regard, please be informed that Executive Secretary Eduardo Ermita formally wrote the undersigned the attached letter, dated March 31, 2006, transmitting the attached desire letter of Her Excellency, President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo, for the election of ANTONIO D. KALAW, JR. as President of the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP) vice Eduardo T. Gonzalez, effective May 31, 2006.

Mr. Kalaw is the DAP Senior Vice-President concurrently serving as the Corporate Secretary of the DAP Board of Trustees. He rose from the ranks in DAP during his thirty (30) years stint in the said institution and has occupied various technical, administrative, managerial and executive positions performing line and staff functions. He is also a Career Executive Service Officer (CESO) and the next in rank after the incumbent outgoing DAP President. We have also attached herewith a copy of this resume for your reference.
